MR James (1862-1936) was provost of Eton College and King's College, Cambridge, as well as being Vice-Chancellor of Cambridge University. A noted and respected medievalist and cataloguer, he was the author of many scholarly and topographical books, but is best remembered today, for his ghost stories, however, the success of these stories is founded in his antiquarian talents and knowledge. Interestingly, James's ghost stories were always intended to be read aloud, and he would unveil a new story to his Cambridge students every Christmas Eve.
